402 Electronics – which includes...garage door openers, I-pods, portable DVD players, digital cameras, video cameras, vehicle stereo systems, laptops, PDAs

270 Publications – which includes...magazines, textbooks, mail, school supplies. *Your mail includes your home address; therefore, letting the thief know where you live and that you are at work/school during this time of day. Also, you may be sending checks through the mail to pay your bills. Your checks contain personal information that the thief can use to access your accounts.*

188 CDs, DVDs, video games, thumb drives

1085 Personal Items – which includes...currency, wallets, purses, bags, clothes
