

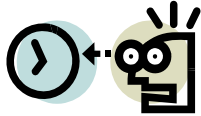

IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES



- February 6** Last day to add a course as audit or to change from credit to audit
- February 10** Last day to file a residency application
- February 10** Students will be assessed an additional 5% late payment penalty on unpaid tuition and mandatory fee balance
- February 10** Deadline for dropping a course without record (after this date it is recorded on transcript and costs \$5)
- February 16** Presidents' Day—Class Holiday, Offices open
- February 25** Students will be assessed an additional 7% late payment penalty on unpaid tuition and mandatory fee balance
