Downtown/Browne's Addition Comments:

1229 W Riverside Ave

- Location: Between downtown and Browne's Addition.
- Amenities: Riverside Ave is a busy street. Sometimes it can get noisy at night with people from downtown making their way home, but there are units that face away from the street into a courtyard that would be quieter. The apartments are spacious, and each one is unique. They were built in 1904, and then renovated around the 70's/80's. So, you do get some older linoleum, appliances, etc. There's little built-in storage, and closets are small. However, if you can get creative (or if you don't have a lot of stuff), it's more than adequate. Heat works well, and I've never run out of hot water, which is a huge plus. The building and units are very picturesque and I'm comfortable living here. It's convenient to downtown and the school via the Centennial Trail. Parking is not so good. There is a lot behind the building, but it's run by the Diamond parking, and their prices are usually steep. Street parking is metered, unless you park out in Browne's Addition, which is what I did. It's a two minute walk to free parking. I eventually got rid of my car, and I'm able to walk to everything I need. If I want to venture outside of downtown, I take the bus - it's better than other cities I've lived in.
- Tips: Weigh out your options. Look at what you're paying for the unit, but also where you'll be living. Some neighborhoods might not feel safe at night. Others might have parking issues. You might pay a little more for rent, but it might outweigh other needs you have. Craigslist usually has some good leads, or just drive by some complexes and give them a call. I don't like modern apartment complexes, so apartment blue book didn't really help me. There are some interesting older places that have charm and comfort that you won't find in there, so be diverse in your search. There are non-generic places out there.

1600 W First Ave

- Location: Browne's Addition is great for those who want to ride bikes to school. It is flat all the way to campus, and you can ride part of the way along the river.

1812 W Riverside Ave

- Location: The neighborhood is relatively quiet. There is a bus stop less than a five minute walk from my building, and there is a Rosauers grocery store two blocks away. It's also comforting that there is a fire station a five minute walk away.
- Amenities: Has a pool.
- General: Apartments are carpeted, have AC and heat, garbage disposals, and both deadbolts and chain locks. The building is open. There's no front door with a buzzer or key access, you simply walk up or down the stairs to the apartment you're looking for. There is one washer and dryer on each floor; laundry is first come first serve. While there is some covered parking, not all apartments have an assigned stall. Some renters and all guests must park on the street.

- Tips: Using sites such as rent.com or apartmentfinder.com help you narrow down the available rentals. If you have to live far away from campus to find something in your price range, the bus system is very reliable, even in the winter, so getting a monthly bus pass is a wise investment.

1824 W 1st Ave

- Location: I can walk to school in about 30 minutes or drive in less than 10 minutes.
- Amenities: Heat and internet are included in rent.
- General comment: The building was built in the 30's. If you like vintage charm and unique apartments, this place is great! I've lived here for over 2 years and intend to stay until I graduate in 3 years. There is a reasonable one-time \$150 fee for pets (I think just cats). The downside is that there have been several car windows broken out around my block, so I am careful not to leave anything out in my car.

2136 W Riverside Ave

- Location: I like that it is a secured building, it has a bus stop right in front the front door, and it has a nice view to the valley.

2400 W Pacific Ave

- Location: Browne's Addition is the best place for students to live - close to restaurants and night life, parks, outdoor activities, groceries, busses, etc.
- Tip: Drive around Browne's Addition to find apartments in houses that are not listed on craigslist.

930 N Washington St

- Location: Easy to get to school by car, not necessarily easy by foot.
- Amenities: Pool is great if you're staying in the summer. Some units allow cats, but not all.
- General: Building constructed in the 70s, but pretty well maintained. Most units have been updated recently and will probably have newer flooring and appliances. Little higher rent than many other place in Spokane, but I was willing to pay extra to feel safe and secure. Building constructed with concrete, making it super quiet and fairly insulated. Close to EVERYTHING in the summer...Hoopfest, Pig Out in the Park, 4th of July.
- Tip: Consider both snowy season and summer season (if you're staying).

930 N Washington St

- Location: It is right by the Oz downtown, Riverfront Park and really close to school. My roommate and I love the location.

401 E Magnesium Rd

South Hill Comments:

112 W Cliff Dr

- Tip: Use the Spokane Crime Map to look at the rate in the area you are looking.

1120 E 19th Ave

- Location: A lot of families, quiet, safe, lots of character.
- General: Found it on Craigslist.
- Tip: Check craigslist, rentals.com

2407 S Grand Blvd

- Location: I love the location. It's surrounded by quiet, safe neighborhoods. Near Manito Park.

2727 E 53rd Ave

- Location: Safe, close to grocery stores, right across the street from Oz Fitness and mail post, 5 minutes from the Pullman-Spokane Hwy.
- General: There is a rec center and pool. The apartments are spacious. The landlords are really helpful and work to help nursing and other students to the best of their ability. If you are interested, they are great to talk to! Very happy.
- Tip: Look around. LOOK EARLY. Don't settle on the first place you find. Tell the landlords that you are staying for 2 years (nursing students), and ours were very happy and helpful in reducing rental costs and giving rental credit! The South Hill is nice!

328 W 8th Ave

- Location: Close to school, close to hospitals. Close to Sacred Heart parking garage.

5015 S Regal St

- Location: Safe area. Bus stop available. Grocery/stores nearby.
- Amenities: Remote garage, plows during the winter, outdoor pool, basketball court, playground.
- General: Very nice apartment. Rent is a little more expensive than those around Trestle, but they usually have a deal going on. Managers are nice and welcoming. OZ Fitness is very close. Approximately 13 minute drive to Riverpoint campus. Remote garage included in the rent.
- Tip: Look around the area to see if you like the surroundings. Look for which stores you normally shop and look around there, because living in the south and grocery shopping up north can get annoying. Ask for specials! They don't always advertise.

5111 S Regal St

- Location: This is not a high end apartment or a low end one. Just in the middle, quite clean and spacious. Comes with a garage which is very helpful during the snow days. Nice neighborhood. Safe and have not had or heard of any theft or violence issues during my stay here.
- Amenities: Garage included with apartment.
- General: The current management is much better than the one we had before.
- Tip: Look in the South Hill area where it is safe with nice neighborhood. An apartment with a garage or covered parking is a plus during Spokane winters.

716 S Arthur St

- Tip: Start early. Search for apartments based on location, price, and other things that are important to you, then call them to see if they have vacancy, then plan a day to go to Spokane and tour all of them.

716 S Arthur St

- Location: Great location. Close to school. Easy commute.

716 S Arthur St

- Location: In a decent neighborhood. Never felt unsafe here. 5 minutes from school.
- General: Two bedroom/two bathroom. Close to the bus line. Managers like nursing students and are very relaxed.
- Tip: Go at night to the location and see if you feel safe. Look at the Spokane police website and investigate crime rates, etc. in that neighborhood.

721 S Lincoln

- Location: There is a great view, and it is a nice neighborhood. If you drive or ride a bike, it is in a good proximity to school.
- Amenities: shared and secure parking garage, dishwasher, real tile floors in kitchen, bathroom, entry
- General: one year contract to start with and last months rent required as well as deposit
- Tip: Make sure it is a safe area with covered parking.

807 S Cowley St

- Location: Really easy access to downtown, campus, and a block and a half walk (well lit and paved) to the front door of Sacred Heart.
- General: Well, it's not the most beautiful part of the South Hill. Within the complex feels secure. The landlord isn't totally "on top of everything," or may take a little while to respond, but just be persistent (while still being polite).
- Tip: Decide how much you want to pay (set limits), how far you are willing to drive, and go from there. Also, it helps if you decide where you want to cut corners-- is it important to you to have two bathrooms, a garage? If there are thing you KNOW want, you might have to make exception on paying more.

807 S Cowley St

- Comment: Quiet and safe. Just next to the hospital and very close to downtown, freeway, school, and South Hill. Bus route 2 is passing by here.
- Amenities: Individual Garages
- General: If you live here, I highly recommend you live on the top floor. You will get a great view and more sunlight.
- Tip: Try craigslist as well.

926 S Cannon St

- Amenities: Pool.
- Tip: Stay close to campus.

Spokane Valley Comments:

13303 E Mission Ave

- Location: Easy freeway access, great for varying clinical locations.
- Amenities: Gated community, also has a heated pool during spring and summer.
- General: There is a rent discount for a longer lease, so you might want to consider signing a year at a time. There are some units that are close to the freeway and have road noise, but only the buildings on the edge of the development.

13310 E Mission Ave

- Location: The apartments are about 30 years old. Convenient location in terms of I-90 access and a range of stores on Sprague (south) and the Valley Mall (north). About half a mile from Valley Hospital.
- General: These are advertised as luxury apartments and are nicer than many other options, but aren't as nice as the complex across the street (Whimsical Pig) or other options. For the price, they are decent.
- Tip: Try to live close to campus.

3700 S Old Schafer Rd

- Location: Quiet neighborhood just outside city limits.
- Amenities: Attached 2-car Garage, central A/C.
- Tip: Make sure to do a crime report on your neighborhood prior to signing a lease.

726 N McDonald Rd

- Location: It's pretty quiet, and it's within 2 miles of a great Starbucks, Target, Safeway, RiteAid, and Goodwill. Also, Winco is really close.
- General: Even though it's in the Valley, it really doesn't take any longer to get to school than it does for the people living in Spokane itself. I like living here. So does my cat.
- Tip: Some places give better prices on Craigslist than they list on forrent.com or other sites. They also might be willing to haggle, and one place I found even gave a medical student discount!
